- Ethnic and race relations, with special emphasis on multi-ethnic societies in Asia and the Pacific
- Crime, law, and deviance, with special emphasis on Hawaii, Asia, and the Pacific region
- Health, aging, and medical sociology, with emphasis on Hawaii, Asia, and the Pacific region

In addition, the curriculum has depth in social research methodology courses, including survey research, field methods, and multivariate analysis.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR

The Sociology Minor requires five upper division sociology courses (15 credits), and one of those courses must be at the 400-level.

- **Required Course: SOC 300 - Principles of Sociological Inquiry** (This course is the pre-requisite for the 400-level Sociology courses.)

The remaining four courses are electives. These may be chosen from any of the 300-level and 400-level courses we offer. At least one course must be at the 400-level.
